Cestui Qui Vie Acts: 1666 and 1707 – Rebuttal and Remedy After Life Claim;

Cestui Qui Vie Act 1666

An Act for Redresse of inconveniences by want of Proove of the Deceases of Persons beyond the Sea or absenting themselves, upon whose Lives Estate depend

CQV 1666, Section XIV

“If the supposed dead Man prove to be alive, then the Title is vested. Action for mean Profits with Interest”

Cestui Qui Vie Act 1707 Ch. 72, 6 Anne, Section XV

“Guardians, Trustees, &c. Holding over without consent of the Remainder Man, &c, deemed Trespassers. Damages”

“And every Person who as Guardian or Trustee for any Infant, and every Husband seised in Right of his Wife only and every other Person having any Estate determinable upon any Life or Lives who after the Determination of such particular Estates or Interest without the express Consent of him her or them who are or shall be next and immediately entitled upon, and after the Determination of such particular Estates or Interest shall hold over and continue in Possession of any Manors, Messuages, Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments shall be and are hereby adjudged to be Trespasses and that every Person and Persons his, her and their Executors and Administrators who are or shall be entitled to any such Manors, Messuages, Lands, Tenements and Hereditaments upon or after the Determination of such particular Estates or Interests shall and may recover in Damages against every such Person or Persons so holding over as aforesaid and against his, her or their Executors or Administrators, the full Value of the Profits received during such Wrongful Possession as aforesaid”

## Annexure 4

### Evidence the Birth Certificate Is Not Proof of Identity

#### (a) Human Rights Tribunal of Ontario – Decision 2012 XY v HM the Queen in Right of Ontario

(as represented by the Minister of Government and Consumer Services) and

Intervenor: Ontario Human Rights Commission

Testimony cited in the decision:

Paragraph 29

“Ms Hartman testified that while the birth certificate contains information about a vital event, namely, a birth (such as the name of a person born, the date and location of his or her birth, and the person's sex), it is not possible to determine whether a person presenting a birth certificate is the person named on the certificate made by looking at the document”

Paragraph 178

“The respondent points out that the birth certificate is not a form of personal identification in any event, in the sense that it cannot be presented to confirm the identity of the bearer”

For the purpose of clarification in this matter, Ms Hartman ( XY) is the Plaintiff, and the Respondent in this matter is the Agent for HM Queen Elizabeth II , Minister of Government and Consumer Services ( not the Registrar General )

#### (b) UK General Register Office FOI Response 16/07/2010

Selwyn Hughes, Communications Manager, Identity and Passports Service/ General Register Office, reply to Freedom of Information Request about the Birth Certificate

“To take birth certificates first – as you say, if you were to lose your birth certificate, you could freely apply for a replacement. And so could anyone else, of any entry which they can identify”

“Providing that you can identify the necessary information, you can purchase a certified copy of someone else's birth entry”

“That clearly means that just because you happen to hold a certified copy of an entry doesn't in itself mean that you are the person to whom the entry relates”

“The certificate is evidence that a particular event took place (a birth)... It does not prove that the person holding the certificate is the person whose registration is reproduced on it”

“In practice, birth certificates play a part in the verification of identity by acting as a support to other information or documentation provided”
