Original document and copies printed single-sided, with the reverse side of each page marked “This side intentionally left blank” – otherwise the Judge can claim there is nothing there in the document. All pages of copies to be certified as a copy of an original document, signed/autographed and dated. 3. All the documents above are legal documents. Legal document signatures are accepted in either blue or black ink. Blue denotes the creditor, not the debtor; black denotes the dead, not the living. Purple is alluded to as pertaining to the soul or royalty; there is no foundation of fact yet seen by the Albion Sovereign Assembly Glue team to provide clear, unambiguous evidence that a purple signature is regarded and, therefore, accepted as a correctly executed document by the legal system. 4. Ultimately, the above is simply guidance (NOT rules). It is the suv'erans documents, so you are welcome to use any size of document and signature/autograph technology you wish. Based on present knowledge, we suggest blue ink is the better option, especially if the documents are to be presented as evidence in a court of Admiralty.
